Classroom Expectations

- 1.) Everyone will be treated with respect at all times.
- 2.) Putdowns and purposefully hurtful comments or actions will not be tolerated.
- 3.) No one will be allowed to disrupt the learning process of anyone else. Students should enter the classroom in a quiet manner.
- 4.) Students should arrive promptly (be in their assigned seat) for class each day with all the materials required for a productive learning experience.
- 5.) If a student has a question or a comment, they must raise their hand and be called upon to speak.

Grading

Grades will include all of the following aspects and will be weighted accordingly:

- 1.) Major Projects (50%): this will include all projects and chapter/unit tests.
- 2.) Daily Work (30%): this will include all work completed during class, participation in discussions, quizzes, and completion of the daily assignment notebook.
- 3.) Homework (20%): this will include all out of class assignments.

Daily Materials

Students will be expected to arrive to class each day with:

- 1.) Binder (with paper and social studies folder)
- 2.) Classroom Journal (Notebook)
- 3.) Pens and/or Pencils
- 4.) Assignment Notebook
- 5.) Textbook
- 6.) Homework assignments from the previous day.

Homework

Homework will be given on a daily basis, and may include short readings, answering questions, or completing short-term projects. It is the responsibility of each

student to be aware of each night's homework assignment, and to promptly turn it in on the correct due date. If a student is unable to turn in a completed assignment on the correct due date, they will be subject to the following Team Adventurers Guidelines:

Papers that are late for reasons other than absence will only receive partial credit. A paper that is one day late will receive 85% credit. If it is two days late 70% credit will be given. If an assignment is three days late, the student will receive only 50% credit. Assignments that are more than three days late will be given a zero.

For those students who are absent from class, it becomes their responsibility to find out what assignments were missed, and to complete them in a reasonable timeframe.
